

Collaboration Planning- Energy

- Goals
 - Affect which energy technologies get deployed and who owns them
 - “Building community power” as thematic point for that goal
 - Strategies
 - Work from the inside, find an ally in power or work into positions of power
 - Tactics
 - Justice
 - Making cost of decisions personal, clear. and powerful
 - Develop tax structures that allow for community investment (bridge incentives for communities that can't get there on their own)
 - Action Plans
 - Identify revenue streams for community investment
 - Identify/create institutional demand
 - Support network for entrepreneurs in solar
 - Empowering municipal access to management of energy services
 - Franchise agreement
 - Challenge management
 - Political education about why democratic control is important
 - Identify narratives that challenge existing structure
 - Tracking innovation and engaging community imagination
 - Environmental refugees, racism
 - Reposition energy as a service rather than a commodity
 - Equity and community wealth building
 - Need some way to distinguish this effort from other similar efforts
 - Raising capital in a way that transforms the economy, identifying and creating markets in a way that transforms the economy
- Synthesis and coordinate process of doing education in more communities, including rural areas. How do we leverage that to building power in other cities
- Build relationship with Endowment Fund, which has capital, and leverage relationships at other institutions to provide resources to other projects; also looking into some tools
